On 17 May 2021, the ESPEN guidelines provide a simple approach for nutrition in obesity (BMI ≥ 30). Use the adjusted body weight rather than the actual weight. The adjusted body weight is equal to the ideal body weight plus one third of the difference between the actual weight and the ideal body weight. We recommend nutrition support therapy in the form of early enteral nutrition should be initiated within 24–48 hours in the patient who is unable to maintain voluntary intake. We suggest patients at high nutrition risk or severely malnourished should be advanced to goal feeding as quickly as tolerated over 24–48 hours. Goal is to provide 80% of estimated protein and energy.
