thinking governed by clear intellectual standards but not every thinking is critical to identify a critical thinking from the uncritical we refer to some standards there is a consensus among philosophers that for thinking to be critical it has to meet certain standards standard of critical thinking web 1 mai 2022 critical thinking is the ability to reflect deeply analyse and interpret information and make considered decisions it is the opposite of making snap decisions and following gut feelings a critical thinker can synthesise information to problem solve collaborate strategise assess risk and deal with uncertain or ambiguous

evaluate and respond to arguments web critical thinking is the analysis of available facts evidence observations and arguments to form a judgment the subject is complex several different definitions exist which generally include the rational skeptical and unbiased analysis or evaluation of factual evidence critical thinking is self directed self disciplined self monitored and self web critical thinking is the act of analyzing facts to understand a problem or topic thoroughly the critical thinking process typically includes steps such as collecting information and data asking thoughtful questions and analyzing possible
